New Features and Enhancements

Oregon and New Mexico Weight Mile Tax

Users can now create a tax filing for Oregon and New Mexico Weight Mile Tax (HUT).

Note: For Omnitracs Tax Manager to accurately calculate fuel taxes, you must create a tax account and assign vehicles to the account, as well as creating vehicles with accurate information.


New Pagination Display

Several of the screens in Tax Manager now allow you to choose the number of items displayed in a single page.

- Tax Filing




Filtering Pages

To help limit the number of items displayed to only the ones you are interested in, you can now filter some lists in Tax Manager.

To filter a list, click the Filter icon (; a panel opens showing the filter criteria.

Choose the proper criteria; items that meet at least one of the selected criteria will be displayed in the list. The following pages have added filtering:

- Distances
- Vehicles
- Fuel
